- 1. Why do I want to become a full-time missionary?*
- 2. How have I seen the LORD lead and confirm this desire?*
- 3. What am I really passionate about in ministry?*
- 4. How am I currently proactive in cultivating that passion?*
- 5. What am I practically doing to prepare myself for missions?*
- 6. Do I have enough short term experience?*
- 7. Do I have a burden for a specific people group?*
- 8. On what areas of my life do I need to experience freedom and victory before going?*
- 9. Have I limited God on where He can send me or how He can use me?*
- 10. What are the most important qualities I am looking for in a sending agency?*
- 11. What are my priorities concerning an overseas assignment? (location, specific ministry, strong support team, etc.)*
- 12. How have I included my church leadership, my family, and my accountability in my journey towards full-time mission service?*
- 13. How can I make a meaningful difference if I don't go?*

What You Should Know About the Road to Missions with Heart of the Bride

- 1. Contact Heart of the Bride at info@heartofthebride.org*
 - 2. Complete Standard Application*
 - 3. Submission of HOB Reference Forms by 5 references and recommendation from sending Church*
 - 4. Online Personality Profile (DISC)*
 - 5. On sight Interviews at Heart of the Bride in Niceville, Florida*
 - 6. Complete HOB Orientation which includes:
-HOB Cross Cultural Training
-Reading Assignments and Discussions
-Understanding of HOB financial principles, foundational values, and team operation manual*
 - 7. Interview and approval from field leaders*
 - 8. Acceptance Determined.*
- Note: 1-8 usually takes place 2 to 3 months. From step 8 to the mission field takes from 6 to 8 months*
- 9. Overseas Assignment Defined which includes job description, financial package, and fund raising tools.*
 - 10. Cultural and Missionary Orientation with Mission Training Institute in Colorado. SPLCE- required (3 weeks.)*
 - 11. Book ticket when funding reaches 95% commitment*
- Term Commitment of 2-3 years*
